Your eligibility for retired pay may not be denied or revoked on the basis of any error, miscalculation, misinformation, or administrative determination of years of creditable service performed unless it resulted directly from fraud or misrepresentation on your part. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the number of years of creditable service upon which retired pay is computed may be adjusted to correct any error, miscalculation, or administrative determination, and when such a correction is made you will be eligible for retired pay in accordance with the number of years of creditable service, as corrected, from the date retired pay is granted.

2. In the event you are now or later become entitled under any other provisions of the law to retired pay from an armed force or retained pay as a member of the Fleet Reserves or Fleet Marine Corps Reserve, you will not be entitled to retired pay under the provisions of Title 10, U.S.C. 12731.

- g. Is not receiving a ROTC Scholarship (10 USC 2107).
- h. An officer must agree to serve in the Selected Reserve for 6 years in addition to any other Selected Reserve obligation.
- i. Enlist, reenlist, or extend an enlistment in the Selected Reserve for a period of not less than 6 years during the period of 1 July 1985 to 30 June 1988. Prior service, in-service members and officers must meet all above qualifying criteria before taking this action. Non-prior service members may enlist for 6 years and then meet above qualifying criteria.

SECTION II—ENTITLEMENT

2. The date of entitlement will be established the day you meet all of the above criteria. You will be eligible to utilize the GI Bill benefits only when your date of entitlement has been established.
3. When entitlement is established you will be required to sign a Notice of Basic Eligibility (*NOBE*), which will fully explain satisfactory participation, non-participation, expiration period, other entitlements, and prohibited duplication of benefits. The *NOBE* will be provided by your unit.

SECTION III—BENEFITS

4. It will be your responsibility to provide your *NOBE* when applying for the GI Bill benefits. Your local Veterans' Administration (VA) office or the educational institution's Veterans' Affairs office will be able to assist you.
5. Benefits will be provided for pursuit of a program of education at an institution of higher learning approved by the VA. The VA will certify you as full-time, three-quarter-time, or one-half-time student and you will be paid:
 - a. \$140 per month for full-time enrollment.
 - b. \$105 per month for three-quarter-time enrollment.
 - c. \$70 per month for one-half-time enrollment.
 - d. The maximum monthly benefit is 36 months or equivalent. Maximum time to draw unused benefits is ten years from date of entitlement, separation from Selected Reserve, award of baccalaureate degree or equivalent, acceptance of a ROTC scholarship, or designation as an unsatisfactory participant, whichever occurs first.

Starting 1 Jul 85 through 30 Jun 88, if you wait for your scheduled Expiration Term of Service (ETS), you may be eligible for both the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP) Reenlistment Bonus and the GI Bill. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT. In connection with my enlistment in the Army National Guard (ARNG) under the Selected Reserve Incentive Program, I hereby acknowledge that --

1. I meet the eligibility criteria as follows:

(a) I have never previously served in any component of an Armed Force of the United States;

(b) I am a graduate of a secondary school or I am currently attending a secondary school and expect to graduate. I fully understand that I will not become entitled to the initial payment or any subsequent payment of the enlistment bonus until such time as I have completed initial active duty for training, including award of primary military occupational speciality (PMOS), and been awarded a secondary school diploma.

(c) I have been classified as Mental Category Group I, II or III;

(d) I am not enlisting to qualify for a civilian position where membership in the ARNG is a condition of employment;

(e) I am not enlisting for voluntary assignment to full-time active duty or active duty for training in excess of 90 days in support of the Reserve program;

(f) I am enlisting into the Selected Reserve to be trained in military occupational speciality _____, which is approved for bonus entitlement and agree to serve my whole initial enlistment term in that speciality;

(g) I am not selecting an optional enlistment program (i.e., 3x3, 4x2).

2. I incur the obligations of this enlistment as follows:

a. I enlist for a period of 6 years.

b. I will serve satisfactorily, as prescribed by the regulations of the ARNG, the complete 6-year term in the Selected Reserve of the ARNG according to my DD Form 4 and my written agreement and in the military occupational speciality for which enlisted unless excused for the convenience of the Government.

3. I will receive an enlistment incentive as follows:

Education Assistance which provides 100 percent of my educational expenses, including tuition, fees, books, laboratory fees, and shop fees for consumable material used as part of classroom or shop instruction, until I complete a course of instruction, until I complete a course of instruction up to a baccalaureate degree, or the equivalent evidence of completion of study in a nondegree program. The amount of educational assistance may not exceed \$500 in any 12-month period nor a total of \$2,000. The 12-month period will initially be established on the date of enlistment.

4. In the event that my entitlement to educational assistance is terminated for any reason prior to fulfillment of my contract and obligation, I will not be eligible to receive any further bonus payments or educational assistance. If such termination is for unsatisfactory participating; if I move out of my bonus-qualified military occupational specialty, unless expressly directed by the ARNG; or if I voluntarily move to a nonbonus-qualified unit within 50 miles or 1½ hours travel time from the unit in which enlisted, I will refund a pro rata amount to the Government calculated as follows:

(a) The number of months obligated service remaining on my contractual term of service divided by the total number of months of obligated service according to my term of enlistment will be multiplied by:

(b) The total amount of educational assistance I have received to date.

5. Any refund made by me will not affect my period of service obligation.

6. If I incur a period of authorized nonavailability and desire to retain education assistance entitlements, I will extend my period of enlistment in the Selected Reserve in order to be able to serve the full obligation period in the Selected Reserve. I will not be eligible for subsequent payments during the period of nonavailability. Entitlement to subsequent payments will resume on the anniversary date of satisfactory, creditable Selected Reserve Service.
